



2020/21 Curriculum Area Scholarship

The Friends of the Center for the Arts (FCFA) at Henrico High School has established two scholarships for each of the Center for the Arts' (CFA) four Curriculum Areas to deserving students who will be enrolled in an arts-related course of study in a qualified college or university setting.

To be eligible for consideration for this scholarship, two Application Components are required:

- a Personal Statement, described below
- the Student Identification Form, attached

The chosen recipients of the Curriculum Area Scholarships will each receive a \$750 award, to be paid directly to the recipient's institution of higher learning. The recipient will be responsible for providing proof of matriculation at the institution (e.g., a copy of a student ID card or course schedule). The proof plus address and account number to which the financial award will be sent must be received by Dr. Stephanie Poxon, Director of CFA, by September 30, 2021. This scholarship is nonrenewable.

The complete Application packet must be submitted to the CFA office by 4:30 p.m., on Friday, April 23, 2021. Your application will be judged on content, including quality of writing and completeness of response to each prompt.

Personal Statement

Applicant must prepare a personal statement of no more than 500 words which addresses each of the following topics:

1. Your goals for higher education
2. Your career or vocational goals
3. Your areas of strength and/or growth in your arts field
4. Your comments on the personal benefits of the educational experiences you received while enrolled in CFA.

Submit this essay on a separate sheet of paper.
